When you think of women and how strong they can be together, visualize these women in a remote part of Sub-Saharan Africa. Many have experienced hunger and resources are still hard to come by. ***Yet, you believed and became part of the next chapter. You gave. And your love is helping them thrive.*** Women like Jane.



Jane begins her day at 3:00 a.m., often tending to her land barefoot in darkness and solitude. Her days are full and as the sun rises, she is planting, weeding, cutting, and teaching others about how to get it done, even on the smallest of rented plots. What she learns and succeeds at becomes another new lesson to share.

As you can see in these photos, Sigomere women do not have fancy farming tools, but they share your *can-do spirit*. You are building resilience in a generation of Kenyan women and they, in turn, are modeling determination and income generation for the girls around them.



“I now know how to farm. You cannot take that away. If a crop has been destroyed - locusts, fire, flooding - I can rebuild my farm again with the help of SOAP.” – An older Sigomere woman, Maria, whose house burned down last year. (She is farming again.)
